DO NOT ENTER RANGE BUILDING WITH FIREARMS OR AMMO!

ALL handguns will be inspected for SAFETY before use.

NO AMMUNITION OR GUNS ARE ALLOWED IN THE CLASSROOM BY ANYONE AT ANY TIME!

Please dress appropriately. Open top shirts, tanks and blouses are discouraged as the hot expended rounds can hurt or scar with contact with skin.

If you have a medical condition or disability, please advise us before class so we may accommodate you accordingly. We have wheelchair accessible classroom and range.

Each student will need to bring the following to class;

- Handgun with appropriate ammunition
- Minimum of 50 rounds of full power factory ammunition for your handgun. Please bring NEW purchased ammunition in the box. HANDLOADS are NOT authorized.
- **Do not preload magazines.** They will be unloaded prior to shooting if you do.
- Semiautomatic or revolver allowed. Most calibers permitted. A .22 pistol is not recommended but is permitted.
- Handgun rentals are available for \$10.00. Ammunition for rentals will require the purchase of OUR ammo. It can be purchased from the range the day of class.
- You may purchase all ammo for your personal firearms the day of class.
- You must bring your firearm UNLOADED and CAVED or HOLSTERED.

REMEMBER: Completion of this class DOES NOT authorize you to carry a concealed firearm. Upon graduation of this class and satisfactorily demonstrating of written and practical application skills, you MUST apply to SLED (South Carolina Law Enforcement Division) to become a CWP (Concealed Weapons Permit) holder. SLED requires a \$50.00 cashier's check or money order with application. SLED does not accept cash or checks. This is not required the day of class.

*** If you have never handled a handgun you must contact us prior to class date for guidance.**

Uniform Standards of performance for each task will be evaluated by a written test and practical application. A positive attitude and safe handling of firearms must be demonstrated to the Instructors' satisfaction. Participants who refuse to follow safety practices as demonstrated in class and/or repeatedly act in an UNSAFE manner WILL BE EXPELLED and will not receive a refund. The Training Instructor's judgment will be final in ALL cases.

No refunds on deposits. You must give 48-hours' notice of cancellation to allow a reschedule of your reservation. You are allowed ONE reschedule within six months. NO-SHOWS are forfeited and will not be allowed to reschedule. Cancellations prevent other students from attending.
